Your children have been working on an exciting social studies project, and we'd like you to see their work! **Our Global Goals Project** is based on the United Nation's *Global Goals* campaign to promote sustainable development worldwide by the year 2030 (www.globalgoals.org/.) Our school project has two main purposes: to 'make the goals famous' by educating ourselves and our community, and to take an action - or plan an action - to help make some progress on one of the goals.

Over the course of the year, we have read, watched, discussed and written about many challenges that exist in our world today. We now want our students to experience working on a solution.
